Auto Sit

10 times	Step	Distractions	Tips / notes
	Throw a treat to the left. When your dog comes back to you, wait for them to offer a sit. Mark the instant your dog sits. Feed in position and then throw a treat out to the side	Very low: Inside away from low windows or normal household distractions	If your dog struggles you can ask for a sit
	Same as above	Moderately low: A new room inside	Same as above
	Same as above	Higher: Inside, with distractions such as running kids or near low window	Same as above
	Same as above	Moderately high: In your garden or equivalent	Same as above
	Same as above	High: Outside on a walk	Same as above



Recall

10 times	Step	Prompts	Tips / notes
	Say your recall cue followed by putting your hand out. Mark the instant your dog touches your hand then throw a handful of food on the floor. Run to the other side of the room	Heavy: Make kissy noises, clap your hand, jump around	Don't repeat your recall cue

Loose Lead Walking

10 times	Step	Steps	Tips / notes
	Lure your dog into the heel position. Mark the instant they are in position. Reward then take one step forward. Mark the instant they are in position and reward.	1	If the lead goes tight. Stop and lure your dog back into position.
